





IGNITE FESTIVAL 3RD – 4TH MAY

MAKING A PALM CROSS

At the beginning of Mass we will bless your palm branches and leaves which we wave joyfully as we enter Church. 'Hosanna to the Son of David!' Later, as we listen to the reading of the Passion, we shout with the same crowd, 'Crucify!' This should lead us to reflect on our sins for which Christ died on the Cross. To help us reflect in the coming days we can fashion our palm leaves into a Palm Cross.

The Cross is a reminder of Christ's suffering and death, but also of His great love for us, when He uttered those words from this Cross: *'Father, forgive them!'* and to the repentant thief, *'Today, you will be with me in paradise.'*
